Dato' Khoo has also held key positions in the tech industry, namely as Chairman of PIKOM (1995-1997), Director of the Asian-Oceanian Computing Industry Organization (ASOCIO) (1995-1997) and Chairman of WITSA (2008-2012). A career highlight was when he led a 40-member team as CEO of WCIT 2008 Sdn Bhd to organize the 16th WCIT that took place in Kuala Lumpur. WCIT

2008, jointly organized by MDEC and PIKOM, was declared by then WITSA Chairman George Newstrom as the most successful congress in the series that started in 1978 .
